### From the Pastor's Pen:

The Lenten season is a time for repentance, conversion, and reconciliation. The parishes in the Archdiocese of St. Louis, in conjunction with the USCCB's "The Light is ON for You" campaign, are joining together to offer numerous opportunities for the faithful to partake in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Every Lent, Catholics receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation or speak with a priest after being away from the Church for 10, 15, 25, or more years. As part of this year's initiative we invite you to make a commitment to pray in a special way for family members, friends, colleagues, and neighbors who are alienated from the Church or who are inactive in the practice of their faith. Join us this Lent in quiet prayer for all those who are seeking to reconcile with God and the Church.

Here at St. Ann, we will have a Penance Service on Wednesday night, April 2, at 7pm in the church. We will have extra confessors around to celebrate God's mercy and his desire to reconcile everyone to His love. If you have been away from the sacrament for awhile, this is an excellent opportunity to experience God's mercy again in your life.

In addition to those prayers, I ask your prayers for our two candidates who are journeying toward the 'full communion of the Catholic church" this Easter.
